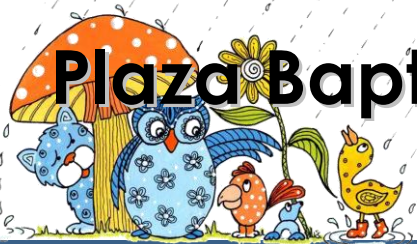

Our developmental goals are to: 1) help the children assume responsibility for their own behavior and actions, 2) to train the children to become more independent in their work, 3) to help the children become aware of the seasonal changes around them and 4) further develop hand/eye coordination through writing, coloring and crafts.
